ORDINANCE No. 8852, OF AUGUST 15th, 2022

Extends the expiration date of LOA PBN and LOA RVSM.

THE GENERAL AVIATION OPERATIONS MANAGER, in the use of the powers conferred upon him by Art. 8th of Ordinance No. 4,919/SPO, of April 30th, 2021, owing to the provisions of the Brazilian Civil Aviation Regulation - RBAC No. 91 and Law No. 7,565, of December 19th, 1986, and considering what is contained in the process No. 00058.048389/2022-22,

RESOLVES:

Art. 1st Extend indefinitely the expiration date of letters of authorization to conduct operations in RVSM airspace (LOA RVSM) issued in accordance with Supplementary Instruction No. 91-005, which expire after August 1st, 2022.

Art. 2nd Extend indefinitely the expiration date of letters of authorization to conduct performance-based navigation operations (LOA PBN) issued in accordance with Supplementary Instruction No. 91-001, which expire after August 1st, 2022.

Art. 3rd The procedures for crew training, aircraft and equipment maintenance, as well as any operational checks necessary to carry out these operations, must continue to be fully complied with by the air operator in accordance with the requirements of Subpart N of the Brazilian Civil Aviation Regulation No. 91 (RBAC No. 91) and the parameters described in IS No. 91-001 and IS No. 91-005, including the provisions of section 91.1709 of RBAC No. 91 regarding the approval in monitoring flight within the deadlines described in item 5.4.1.1 of IS No. 91-005.

Art. 4th ANAC may at any time request evidence from air operators about the compliance of operations with regulations and rules prescribed by ANAC, and any non-conformities or violations may give rise to suspension or revocation of the authorization.

Art. 5th If there is interest, an operator that meets the above conditions, may request ANAC the issuance of LOA RVSM or LOA PBN in the new format that does not have an indicated expiration date and, in this case, Civil Aviation Inspection Fee (TFAC) will not be charged.

Art. 7th This Ordinance enters into force on the date of its publication.
