BRAZILIAN EMERGENCY AIRWORTHINESS DIRECTIVE

EAD No: 2019-03-01

Effective Date: 13 mar. 2019

The following Brazilian Emergency Airworthiness Directive (EAD), issued by the Agência Nacional de Aviação Civil (ANAC) in accordance with provisions of Chapter IV, Title III of Código Brasileiro de Aeronáutica - Law No. 7,565 dated 19 December 1986 - and Regulamento Brasileiro da Aviação Civil (RBAC) 39, applies to all aircraft registered in the Registro Aeronáutico Brasileiro. No person may operate an aircraft to which this AD applies, unless it has previously complied with the requirements established herein.

EAD No. 2019-03-01 - BOEING / 39-1439.

APPLICABILITY: This Emergency Airworthiness Directive is applicable to Boeing Model 737-8 aircraft of all serial numbers with Brazilian registration marks.

CANCELLATION / REVISION: Not applicable.

REASON: Prompted by two fatal accidents with a Boeing 737-8 airplane and given the similarity of the two accidents, it has been decided as a precautionary measure that commercial operations using Boeing 737-8 with Brazilian registration marks should stop until appropriate safeguards are taken in place. This decision is based on the primary certification authority (Federal Aviation Administration – FAA) determination supported by Type Certificate Holder (The Boeing Company) recommendation.

REQUIRED ACTION: From the effective date of this Emergency Airworthiness Directive (EAD), do not conduct commercial operations with the airplanes identified in the APPLICABILITY paragraph of this EAD.

COMPLIANCE: This EAD is considered to be an interim measure pending the outcome of the investigations of both accidents. Further AD action is expected to follow when additional information is available.
